Our shared properties offer

- 2 to 5 private bedrooms used by the young people
- A shared kitchen space for cooking, food preparation and washing clothes
- A shared living space for communal living and Key Working Sessions
- A shared bathroom which includes a toilet, sink and either a bath or a shower
- A back garden for personal enjoyment
- Wifi throughout the house and a landline

- Lockable door for privacy and peace
- Furniture to make your room feel comfortable and welcoming, with space to study and relax
- A welcome pack with all the essentials to start your placement

TV and stand	Stove (oven and hob points)
Dining table and chairs	Fridge and freezer with enough storage for all
Sofa and armchairs	Washing machine and drying hangers
Coffee table	Microwave, kettle, toaster
Wall Mirror	Cleaning items and products
Shoe rack	Storage cupboards with enough space for all
Wall clock, Noticeboard	Cutlery, crockery (plates etc) and cooking items
Internet router and duty phone	Carpeted floors or rugs and runners
