

Your Rights and Responsibilities in Your Home

As a resident, you have the right to:

- live in a safe, comfortable and peaceful home
- a safe supply of gas, electricity, wifi and hot / cold water
- not be upset or scared by anyone else in your home
- if something breaks; it will oe repaired
- to complain if you are not happy with your home
- 24 hours notice before we access your bedroom to check it is safe.
 - We may have to enter your bedroom at any time if we believe there may be a risk of harm to yourself or others.
- be supported in accessing education, employment and training

House Rules

As a resident, you have the responsibility to:

- pay your rent and service charge if asked to
- not to be violent or aggressive to other people for any reason
- respect everyone regardless of their race, religion, age, disability, gender or sexuality
- keep all noise to a quiet level, especially between 10pm and 8am
- be responsible for the behaviour of your visitors
- strictly have no weapons in your home
- keep your home clean, tidy, damage free and respect your space.
- keep your home locked and safe for you and your housemates
- show respect to other residents, visitors and staff
- consider the privacy of other residents
- to use bins correctly and work with us to understand good use of heating and electricity

Visitors:

- Overnight guests need to be agreed and we will need to know their name and age.
- No guests under 16
- You cannot have more than 2 guests at any time
- Visitors are not allowed in the house when you are not there
- You are responsible for the behaviour of your guests, including any damage to the home
- Group gatherings at your home need to be agreed by Pathways staff beforehand

Animal and pets:

• You are not allowed to have any animal or pets on the property.

Smoking, drugs and alcohol:

- No smoking inside the home
- No drugs or alcohol anywhere inside or outside. If we find these, we will remove them





Property:

- Pathways does not insure any personal property or take responsibility for your belongings that are lost, stolen or damaged unless we make a mistake
- Please report any broken or damaged things in your home so that we can fix them

Keys:

- You will get keys to the front door and your bedroom which are for your use only.
- Replacement keys will be issued at a cost of £5 per key

Staying away from your home:

- If you plan to stay away from home please tell your Key Worker
- If you are under 18 your Social Worker must agree for you to be away from your home

Support and keeping in touch:

 All residents are expected to take part in the support provided by your Pathways Key Worker and Social Services
