



# FIRE PROCEDURES

<b>Address</b>	
<b>Designated Meeting Point</b>	
<b>Residents</b>  <i>first names only</i> <i>cross through unused boxes</i>	

Fire and Smoke Detectors are located throughout the house

### If you hear an alarm go off

- Leave the building immediately by the **quickest and safest exit** - either the **front door** or the **back door** and go to the **designated meeting point**.

### If you encounter a fire

- If it is a small fire in the kitchen, you can try to put it out by using the fire blanket in your kitchen. If the fire is large or you are unsure, do not attempt this and **leave**.
- Shout "fire!" to alert other people if alarm has not activated.

### When at designated point

- Call the fire brigade on 999 and provide your **address**, name and details about **your housemates**.
- Call Pathways duty line to inform staff

### Do

- turn off close by electric and gas appliances if safe to do so
- when encountering smoke remain low to the ground as you leave.

### Do not

- Attempt to collect personal items before leaving the house
- Attempt to find friends or housemates in the house
- Remain in the house once you have been warned (alarm or shouting)
- **DO NOT RETURN TO THE HOUSE FOR ANY REASON**
